# Gateway Technical College Launches New Campus ID Card Program with CardSmith

The new program replaces the College's previous campus card that was used primarily for identification purposes.

The new GatewayOneCard is powered by CardSmith's cloud-based transaction system, providing advanced transaction services without on-campus systems or software, or dedicated administrative staff. The service features web and account access and funds transfer service, on-line reporting, on-line administrative access and 24/7/365 monitoring. The College is also utilizing CardSmith's RapIDCard card production solution, which is tightly integrated with the transaction system.
