## **Fairleigh Dickinson University and CardSmith Sign Long-term Contract Extension**

Teaneck, N.J. (June 29, 2009) — Fairleigh Dickinson University (FDU) and CardSmith LLC today announced a multi-year renewal and extension of their campus card-services agreement. Under the agreement, CardSmith provides Fairleigh Dickinson and its Teaneck and Madison, N.J., campuses with a comprehensive management service for the Fairleigh 1Card, the university's multi-application ID card.
